James was a 21-year-old mechanic with his whole life ahead of him, when an industrial accident caused him to be thrown from the vehicle he was driving. As a result of not wearing a seatbelt, James sustained injuries so severe, that he will be confined to a wheelchair for the rest of his life.

James is now a Paraplegic!

After three months hospitalisation and a further five months of intensive rehabilitation, James started a new life facing mental, emotional and physical challenges every day.....learning how to live again.

Sadly, not only the victim of an accident has to recover from a workplace injury!

It is no exaggeration to suggest that 'everyone' suffers - children, parents, intimate friends, work colleagues, the Supervisor/Manager who has the unpleasant task of informing families that an accident has occurred.

Now James dedicates his time sending a clear message that '**prevention IS better than cure**'... because what James has is incurable.
